Course Description

This four day comprehensive training course is designed to broaden the expertise of nurses and physicians who currently provide or will be providing pediatric sexual abuse/assault medical evaluation. The focus of this Canadian-based, intermediate to advanced level training will be on caring for the sexually abused pediatric population. This evidence-based course will be interactive, case-based and provide practical opportunities for clinicians to obtain feedback on different practice elements including documentation. A separate clinical preceptorship must be completed following this 4 day interactive, in-class training portion in order to complete all components of the course.

This clinical component will include the completion of 20 pediatric forensic examinations including documentation following the training course.



This training will not “certify” SANEs to perform pediatric sexual assault exams independently.

In order to secure a spot at the training, your registration form and payment must be received by November 1st, 2009.

Specific topics to be covered

- Pediatric growth and development as it relates to sexual assault examinations
- Sexual development and sexualized behaviours
- Identification and interpretation of ano-genital findings
 - Normal variants and medical conditions that mimic abuse
 - Discussion of interpretation of anal/genital findings – review of current literature
- Documentation including photo documentation
- Forensic evidence collection
- Expert testimony
- Sexually transmitted infections in children
- Role of child protection & law enforcement
- Physical abuse & neglect
- Case reviews

Target Audience

Nurses who have:

- received training as a Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner — Adult/Adolescent
- practicing for over 1 year in the area of sexual assault
- currently providing or will be providing service for pediatric sexual abuse/assault victims

Physicians who are:

- currently providing or will be providing medical evaluation for pediatric sexual abuse/assault victims

Registration Information

The cost of this course is \$500⁰⁰. This fee covers your course materials, speakers, venue and expert review, discussion and feedback of clinical cases during clinical preceptorship following the course. This amount does NOT include travel or accommodations.

**preceptor may be a physician, advanced practice nurse or pediatric trained SANE. The letter must include the preceptor's title, place of employment, contact phone number, area of practice and description of experience in performing pediatric sexual assault/abuse exams.
