Course Description

This four day comprehensive training course is designed to broaden the expertise of nurses and physicians who currently provide or will be providing pediatric sexual abuse/assault medical evaluation. The focus of this Canadian-based, intermediate to advanced level training will be on caring for the sexually abused pediatric population. This evidence-based course will be interactive, case-based and provide practical opportunities for clinicians to obtain feedback on different practice elements including documentation.
